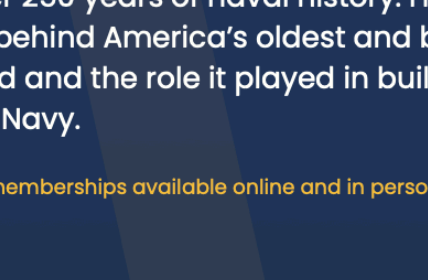

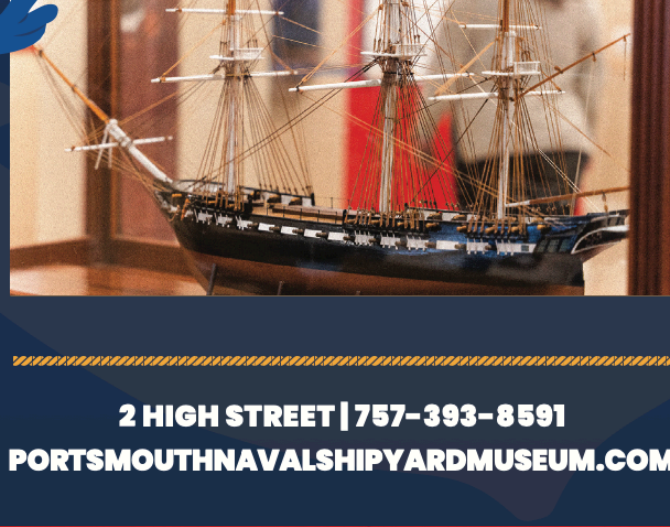

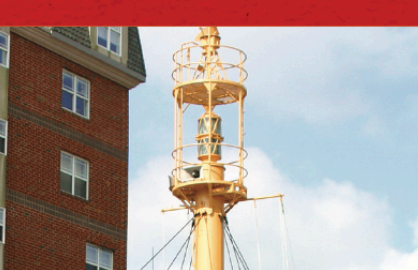


Discover 250 years of naval history. Hear stories behind America's oldest and biggest shipyard and the role it played in building the U.S. Navy.
